WE ARE LEARNING:

<u>RELIGION</u>: We will explore Ch. 22, *Jesus Sends the Apostles*, next week. Students will take a quiz over Ch. 21-22 on Tuesday, May 14th.

MATH: We are continuing to work on pre-algebra with expressions containing one and two variables. We will also work on graphing points on a coordinate plane. We will have our last DMR quiz on Friday, May 10th. We will continue time tests until May 17th. IXL lessons V1 and V2 are due on Monday, May 6th.

LANGUAGE ARTS- We had a few more narrative writings to share this week and completed some spring writing prompts. We started discussing the topic of plagiarism, the various types, and how to avoid it when writing. We will start back up with Simple Solutions next week.
